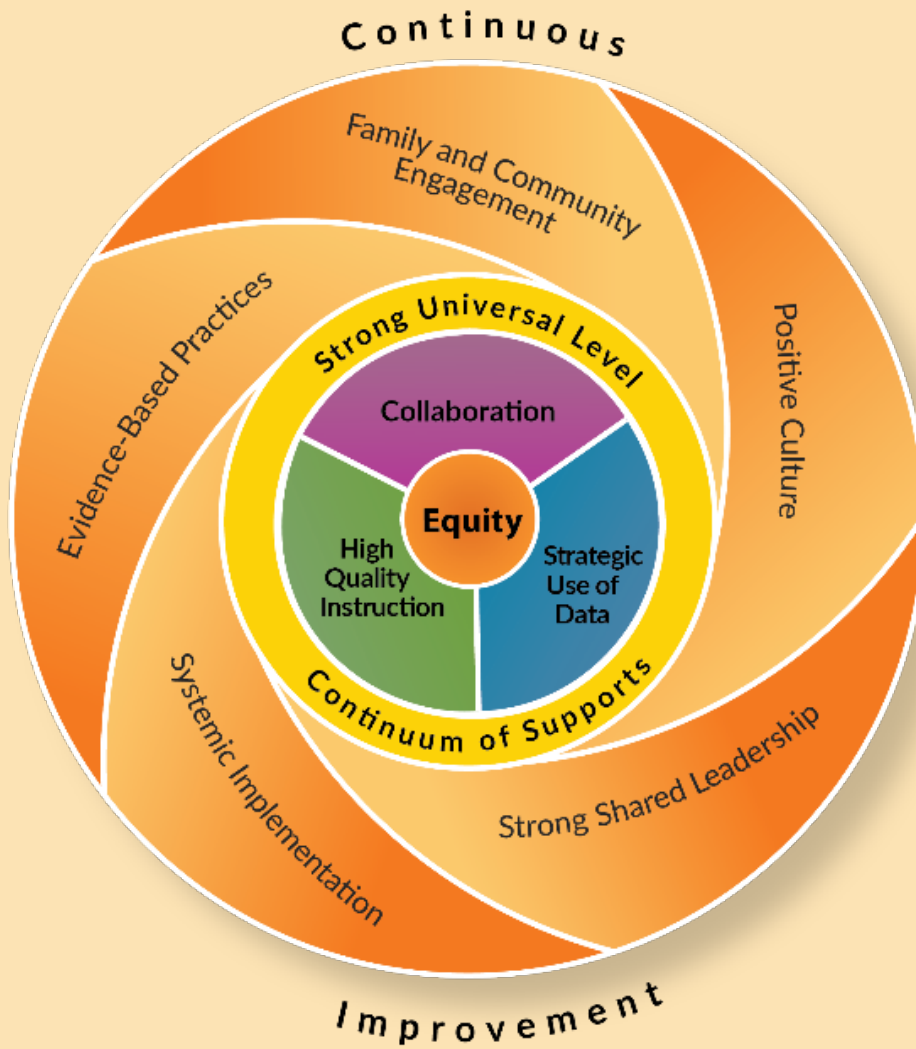


Family Engagement Resources in a Multi-level System of Supports
