- IEP team must address with additional supports and services
- IDEA 22-001 & IDEA 22-037

IDEA Complaints Participation in Extracurriculars

- FAPE extends to Extracurricular Activities
- IEP team to determined supports and services
- IDEA 22-001 & 22-013

IDEA Complaints Manifestation Determinations

- Comprehensive Review of existing information required before making "direct and substantial" determination.
- IDEA 22-007 & IDEA 22-024

IDEA Complaints LRE

- Individual determination
- Continuum must be considered
- IEP team decision
- IDEA 22-013, IDEA 22-016 & IDEA 22-025

IDEA Complaints Shortened Day

- Based on student's needs
- Other options considered
- IEP team decision
- IDEA 22-16 & 22-025

IDEA Complaints Seclusion and Restraint

- Imminent safety risk
- Proper protocols
- Proper notice
- IDEA 22-027

Procedural Compliance Self-Assessment

- New cycle begins this year
- One new evaluation item, five new IEP items
- New area examining shortened day requirements

Eligibility Criteria

- Criteria revisions for many eligibility areas in spring 2022.
