Our History:

Since beginning in 1995, WI FACETS has had a vision that all children receive the education they need to be successful. Founded by a small group of committed parents who had a strong desire to help other families –when our doors opened, we had 2 part time staff, a tiny office, and served just one community. Since then, WI FACETS has grown greatly. We now have a much larger, diverse staff who serve the entire state through a wide variety of programs designed to assist individuals, families and professionals.



HOW WE HELP FAMILIES

WI FACETS is committed to empowering Wisconsin families and young adults with disabilities by helping them gain the knowledge, skills, and confidence to advocate for themselves. Many of our services are open not only to families but also to professionals who work with children with disabilities. We currently offer a variety of free services to families across Wisconsin, including:

Training

WI FACETS provides over 100 workshops annually for families of children with disabilities and those who support them. All trainings are easy to access and free of charge.

Help Desk Toll Free Line

We know that when a parent needs help, the last thing they need is to have to navigate a complicated phone menu or use a chat bot on a website. When families call our toll-free help desk line with questions and concerns, they will be able to speak to one of our staff members who understands and is committed to helping them.

Individual Assistance

Some families are experiencing very complex situations. For those families, WI FACETS offers intensive support (including IEP reviews and meeting preparation), as well as a limited amount of in person support for families at school meetings, mediations, and facilitated IEPs.

Leadership Development

WI FACETS provides parents and young adults with disabilities with leadership training and mentoring so they may feel empowered to represent the parent and youth voice in important conversations and decisions. Having skilled parent and youth leaders is critical in shaping the direction of programs and services.

We offer free trainings each year for families and youth with disabilities. Professionals who support children with disabilities are always welcome to attend as well. Our trainings cover a wide range of matters that are relevant to the disability and special education communities and range from the basics of the IEP process to more specialized and emerging needs topics. Our trainings aim to provide practical, credible, and up-to-date information.

By offering these trainings at no cost, we aim to build a more informed and inclusive community. Whether you are a parent, young adult with a disability, caregiver, educator, or service provider, our trainings may be beneficial.

Each year, our team cultivates a year-long lineup of workshops and speakers that is unique and reflective of the current special education and disability landscape. Additionally, WI FACETS offers a robust line up of trainings provided in Spanish and with translated and culturally appropriate materials.




2024 FINANCES
